Primary text: **Though he slay me, yet will I hope in him.** (Job 13:15 NIV)

Primary point: A human's greatest achievement is to glorify God by loving God unconditionally.

The purpose of the book of Job

Job answers an even more important question than Genesis: Why are we here.

What is unconditional love for God?

Dan 3:13-18; Acts 5:40-41; Rom 5:6-8

We need to grow in our reverence for the high God

Because He is God, He has the right to allow us to unfairly suffer and still expect us to revere and worship Him to glorify Him.
